SKATING CLUB OF MAINE MEMBERSHIP DEFINITIONS

HOME CLUB MEMBER is a person whose primary skating membership resides with the Skating Club of Maine. This individual is registered with U.S. Figure Skating under the Skating Club of Maine and represents the Skating Club of Maine in competitions. All Home Club Members 18 years of age or older are voting members of the Skating Club of Maine.

HOME CLUB 1ST FAMILY MEMBER is the first person in a family to sign up for a membership. Only one member of the family needs to be designated as the 1st Family member and must pay \$80. All other individuals in the family can then join as Subsequent Family Members at \$20.

SUBSEQUENT FAMILY MEMBER is any individual in a family after the 1st family member to join the Club. The Subsequent Family Member fee is \$20.

JUNIOR MEMBER is the first person in the family to sign up for membership with SCM, and is the primary skating membership resides with the Skating Club of Maine. This member has not yet taken any USFSA tests, but wishes to have private lessons on Freeskate ice. This individual is registered with U.S. Figure Skating under the Skating Club of Maine and represents the Skating Club of Maine in competitions. This member must have a subsequent family member join. A junior members and Subsequent family member will not have voting rights.

COLLEGIATE MEMBER is a person who is attending a four year college and still wishes to keep U.S Figure skating membership. This membership carries the same privileges as a first family member including skating and competition privileges. This membership is discounted and is paid for as a four year membership fee. Knowing being college leaves little time to use SCM this membership will keep the person eligible at a low fee for when they are on breaks.

ASSOCIATE MEMBER is a person whose U.S. Figure Skating registered home club membership resides with a club other than the Skating Club of Maine. This individual does not represent the Skating Club of Maine in competitions and must have all competition and test applications signed by an officer or Board member of the home club to which they belong, not by any representative of the Skating Club of Maine. Associate members are not voting members of the Skating Club of Maine and may not hold elected or appointed office on the Board of Directors or Regional Steering Committees.

SUPPORTING MEMBER is a non-skater or member of a non-skating family. This individual is a voting member and may, if U.S. Figure Skating eligibility is met, be elected or appointed to the Board of Directors of the Skating Club of Maine.
