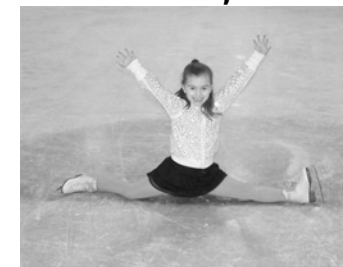

ADDITIONAL CLASSES

Basic Skills Stoking: \$40

This class will be mandatory for Advanced Skaters. Lessons are based on power, posture and endurance. The class is offered on Saturday from 10:00-10:15AM.

Off-Ice Dance Class: \$60

This class is offered to Snowplow Sam—Basic 8, Advanced and Adult Skating Club of Maine-Northern Region members. The class instructor, Shayna da Cruz, will focus on jazz, lyrical, hip hop and other varieties of off ice dance that will be incorporated into the sport of figure skating. Classes will begin the week of November 9th, 2009 and end the week of February 2nd, 2010.
